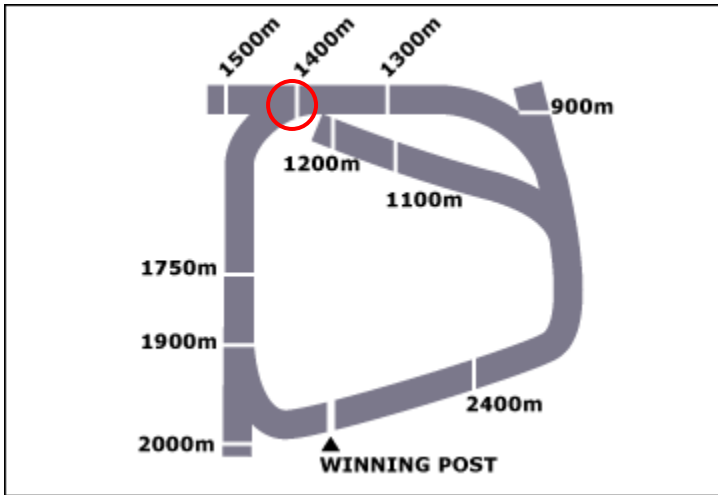


# This Saturday's Feature Race...

## Mr Racing's Predicted Finishing Order:

1 <sup>st</sup>	<b>8 MENTALITY</b> (D.Beadman)	\$2.30 Won well first-up and meets runner-up F.Afield even better today.
2 <sup>nd</sup>	7 Fashions Afield (D.Beasley)	\$3.80 Solid first-up. Mentality has no second-up form. She'll keep him honest.
3 <sup>rd</sup>	2 Desert War (H.Bowman)	\$6.50 Runs 3 <sup>rd</sup> nearly everytime he races first-up against the best company.

## Worthy Mentions:

1	Eremein (G.Boss)	\$11.0 Resumes after an injury-enforced layoff. Too honest to ever write off.
4	Confectioner (T.Clark)	\$16.0 Fresh form is excellent. Has had a let-up since WA Group 1 events.

## Summary:

Small field for the Apollo Stakes. Forced to stick with the horses who have had the run back and are best accustomed to the shorter trip in **Mentality** and **Fashions Afield**. Hard to see Fashions Afield turning the tables on Mentality. I suspect **Desert War** still might be the best of the first-uppers, despite appearing flat in his trials. Expect a bold showing, come raceday. **Eremein's** class can never be discounted, however he generally takes a run to come to hand. When right, he really doesn't know how to get beaten, especially here at Rosehill (home track), where he has 5 wins from 8 starts.
