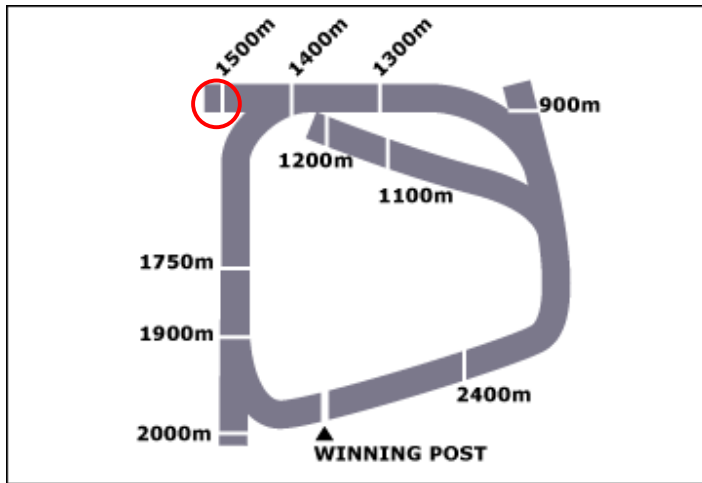

- 1st** **3 FASHIONS AFIELD** (D.Beasley) \$5.50 Shudder at the thought of backing this jockey, but hardest to beat.
- 2nd** 5 Regal Cheer (J.Cassidy) \$7.00 A long time between wins, but proven this grade at track & distance.
- 3rd** 1 Rewaaya (C.Williams) \$8.50 Poorly drawn, but did beat Miss Andretti over 1400m last prep. Classy.

Best Roughie:

- 8 Tuesday Joy (D.Beadman) \$9.00 3yo better placed over more ground, but gets a soft run & hits the line.

Summary:

We witnessed Mentality taking Sydney WFA form back to 3yo company to destroy them and I think we may see something similar from **Fashions Afield**, who brings Desert War, Eremein, and Mentality form back to mares grade. She'll make her own luck, unlike a lot of her dangers, and take beating. **Regal Cheer** is racing honest without winning. Should be peaking on the day and has run very well in the past in Coolmore Classic and Queen of the Turf here. **Rewaaya** adds a bit of spark to this race. One of the nation's top class mares. Drawn off the track, but will be storming home.
