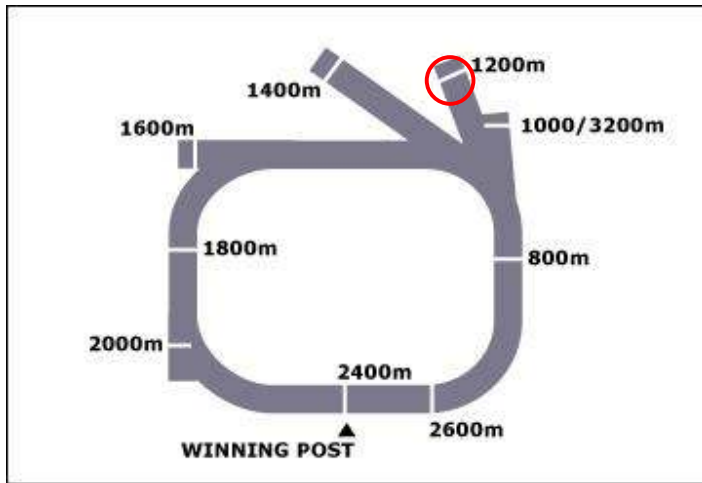

4 th	6 Bentley Biscuit (N.Rawiller)	\$7.0 Will be suited by the early tempo on speed. Expect him to figure late.

9 Fast 'N' Famous (D.Beadman) \$7.5 Ran well in the Galaxy, but meets Spark of Life 5kg worse at the weights

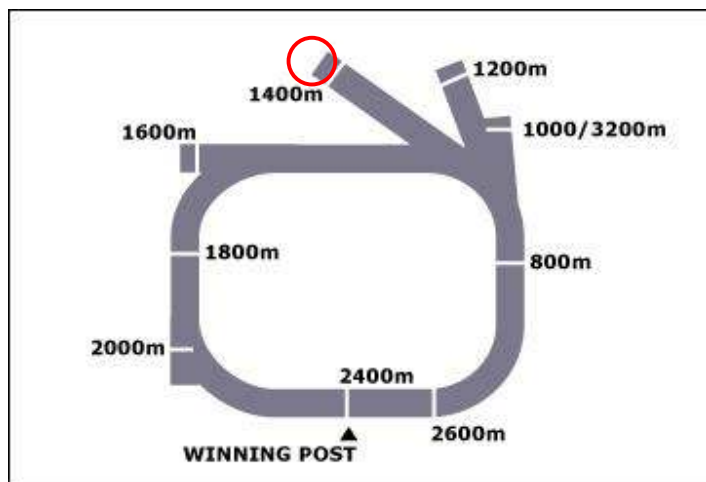
Summary:

Spark of Life is a proven wet tracker and prolific Group 1 sprinter/winner, suited at Weight For Age. Disappointed in the Galaxy, but paraded the best he ever has first-up in the challenge. Hard to beat back to WFA, drawn the rails. **Primus** is capable of giving this a shake fresh. Handles the going and races very well fresh. Classy and suited at 1200m first-up. **Dance Hero**, like Spark Of Life, should appreciate meeting these at WFA. Will be a huge improver. Pay to forgive his Newmarket failure. **Bentley Biscuit** is sure to race well 2nd-up with the run under his belt. Will be doing his best work late.

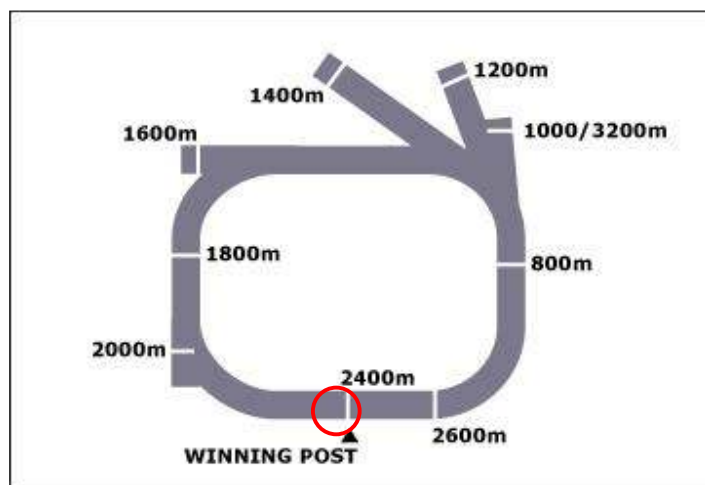
Summary:

Murtajill was heavily backed in the Slipper, but this looks his race. Forced to work too hard from the alley in the Slipper. Would have had a quiet week and has drawn a quiet/soft alley. If you backed him in the slipper... don't miss him here. **Camarilla** was saved from the slipper to let stablemate Forensics win the race. May have been a good move, as she looks hard to hold out here. Will go back and motor home. She should find a lot of these out over the last furlong, when she does her best work. **Zizou** doesn't know how to run a bad race, but he is never going to be a group 1 superstar. Can run a place again from the good alley. **Meurice** looks hard to beat on his slipper run, where he was very unlucky. I'd rather risk him.

3 rd	1 He's No Pie Eater (H.Bowman)	\$7.5	Racing at the top of his game. Not a mile and half horse, but classy.
4 th	7 Fiumicino (D.Beadman)	\$8.0	Rising talent in the 3yo staying ranks. Capable of figuring.

Summary:

I can't remember the last filly to run in the Derby, but there is 2 handy ones here. **Miss Finland** is the best 3yo in the land and has raced a little more dour this prep. Will get the run of the race and take beating. **Tuesday Joy** was ridden upside down in the Arrowfield, in an effort to upset Miss Finland. Going back to her normal pattern of racing (off the speed) today, and up to 2400m, is definitely in her favour. **Fiumicino** is the smokey of the colts and geldings. Lightly raced Zabeel on the up. **He's No Pie Eater** has done nothing wrong and should still have some freshness in his legs. **Gorky Park** will give a big sight back to his own age. Throw Bart Cummings' runners (**Sir James & Fianchetto**) into multis & quaddie at huge odds.
