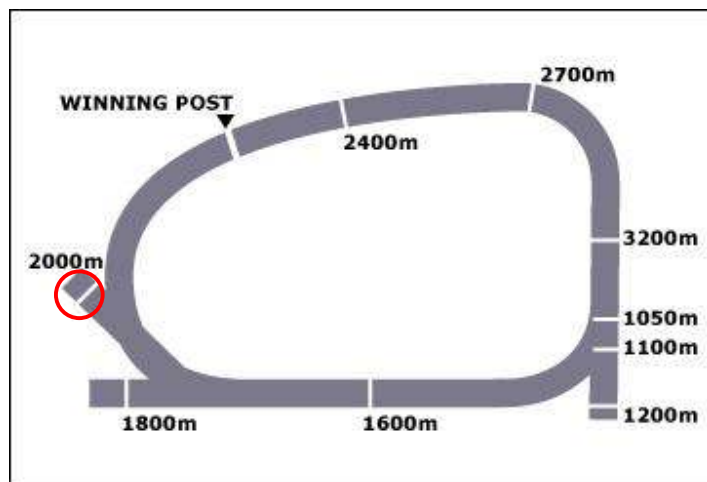

3 <sup>rd</sup>	4 Juste Momente (S.Arnold)	\$6.0 Well bred, well drawn, in-form and top jockey. Gets plenty of ticks.

## Best Roughie:

12 Zingara (S.King)	\$13.0 Zabeel filly who should continue improving with distance and racing.
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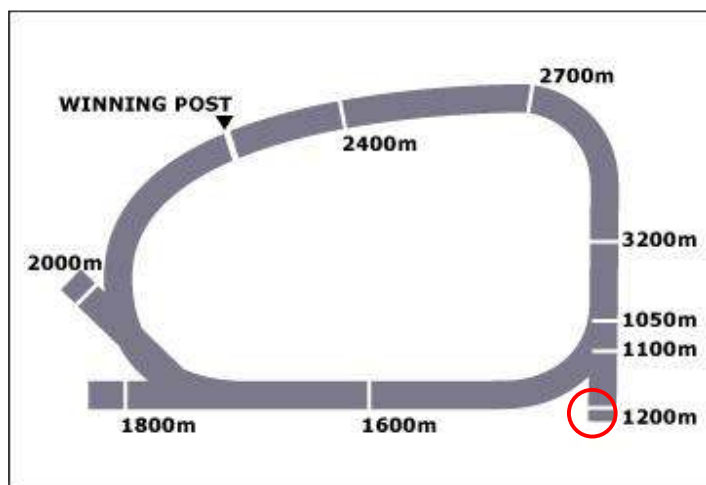
## Summary:

I get the feeling **Anamato's** prep was based around stablemate Miss Finland's plans. IF she had progressed properly from her Kewney win over a mile, beating in-form stablemate Catechuchu, into a race like the Set Weights Arrowfield (won by Miss Finland), she could have had a better Sydney carnival. Bringing her back to 1500m at Set Weights against the older mares, gave her no chance. Here she is today, back up to 2000m and back to fillies set weights. Considering she is probably the third or fourth best filly behind Miss Finland and Tuesday Joy over a distance, she should be winning this. **Devil Moon** is clearly the best local hope. Despite winning her past three in Adelaide, she has a Caulfield win to her credit, beating the likes of Miss Fantabulous convincingly in the Spring. Has plenty of ability. **Juste Momente** is an improving type and has plenty in her favour today. She looms as a danger.

2 <sup>nd</sup>	11 Catechuchu (M.Rodd)	\$4.50	Has been freshened since going down over a mile to Anamato. Go close.
3 <sup>rd</sup>	1 Rewaaya (D.Dunn)	\$7.50	Sure to appreciate the drop and grade and distance.

## Best Roughie:

13 Nediym's Glow (C.Symons)	\$11.0	Talented sprinting filly. She has been around the mark this prep.
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## Summary:

The 3yr olds all the way here. **Universal Queen** and **Catechuchu** clearly on top. **Nediym's Glow**, **Rewaaya** and maybe **Media** the only other winning hopes for mine in the race. I can't get anywhere near **Miss Mooney Mooney** and think she is huge unders in single figure odds. The only thing in her favour is a suitably run race and if the result comes from the speed map alone, she should be able to figure.
