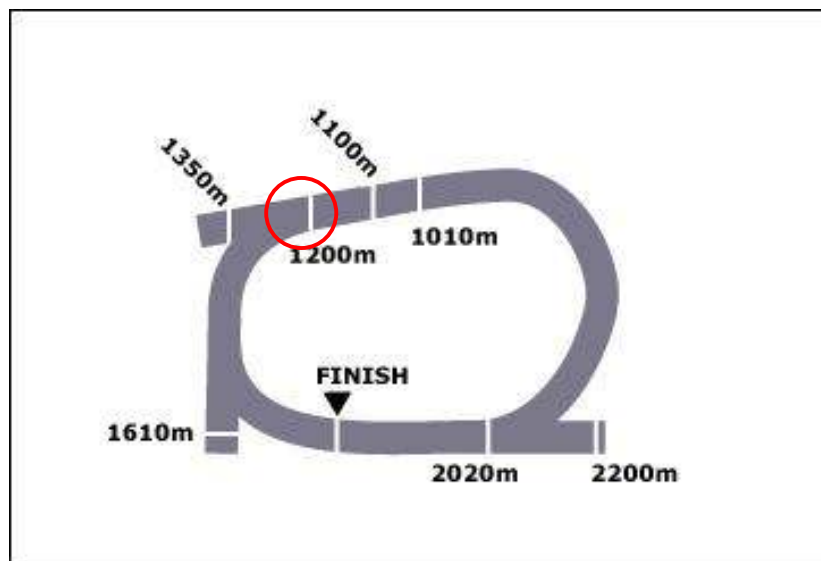

Imagine if Gold Edition and Miss Andretti lined up here! This is an outstanding race. **Bentley Biscuit** needs to take his home state form away with him. I feel he can, considering Brisbane races the "same way". I put a line through his Melbourne Spring campaign and expected a big Autumn in Sydney, and he certainly delivered. Wasn't overtaxed during the carnival, and should have plenty of sprint in his legs to give them a big fright in the BTC Cup, 10,000 and Stradbroke. This was some win last start by **Mitanni**. He went past cut-throating leaders Dance Hero and Spark of Life at half-pace like they were tied to the fence. I don't think that the 1 alley is ideal for this horse. They have certainly found the key to him, in riding him a little quieter than he once was. He has always been a top horse, but I feel far more effective now, than he was when leading in his races. I'm not sure what to makeover of where **Takeover Target** is at, at the moment. All I know is he is one of the best sprinters we have seen anywhere in the world, and if he is anywhere near his best, then he is an obvious winning hope.
