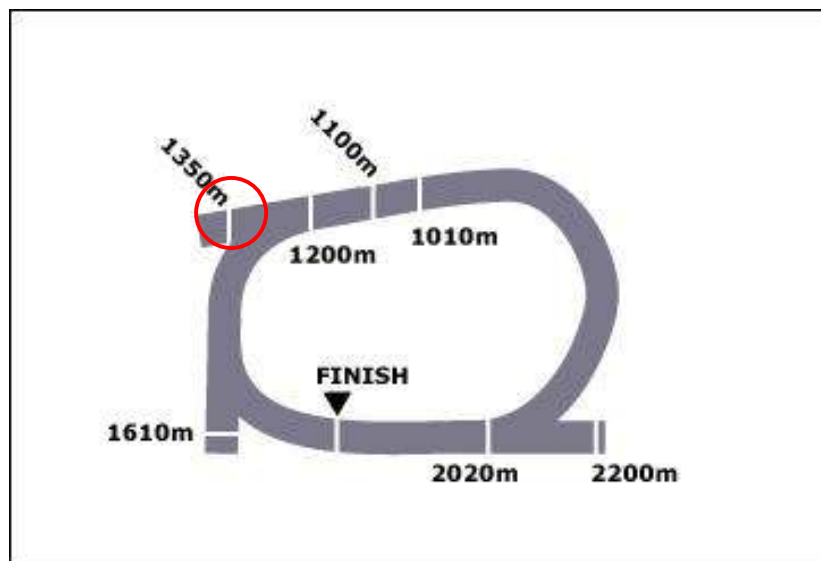

## Summary:

**Gold Edition** and **Takeover Target** should cruise away from this field to settle down and fight this race out, in a true 2-horse war. As long as Jay Ford doesn't get impatient on Takeover Target, or Any Suggestion doesn't do something silly to the detriment of the front 2, then they should go to the line together. I expect the seasoned sprinter and global sprinting champion Takeover Target to reign supreme over the final furlong when it becomes a test of class and attrition. **Mitanni** has drawn somewhat unsuitably again on the inside, but the logical 3<sup>rd</sup> pick. If the leaders go silly, then he will get first crack at them, and go home strong. Malcolm, Media, Royal Ida, Black Ink and Gee I Jane are all nice horses and can hit the line, but they are not WFA class.
