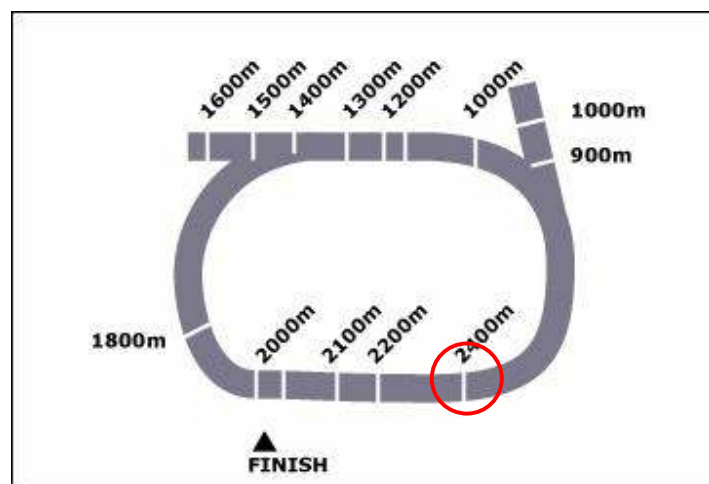

Mr Racing's Predicted Finishing Order:

- 1st** **2 LASORON** (D.Beadman) \$4.50 Remains a query at the trip, but in form and drawn to get the gun run.
- 2nd** 5 Fuji Fantasy (V.Duric) \$6.0 Looks the best staying filly in the race. May need some speed on to win.
- 3rd** 10 Eskimo Queen (G.Childs) \$6.0 Caught the eye last start. Appears to be warming nicely to this.

Best Roughie:

- 3 My Lady's Chamber (Z.Purton) \$9.0 Sire Arena won a Derby at 3. Can't fault her 2 lead-up runs.

Summary:

Not a strong Oaks by any means, and for that reason, I think we can remove the queries that overhang a lot of these and stick with the form. **Lasoron** caught the eye in a big way behind Reigning To Win in the Doomben Classic, and I was more than happy to be on her in the Roses. Remains a query at the journey, but doesn't have much to beat and is drawn to get the gun run. **Fuji Fantasy** has drawn horribly, but she admittedly gets back in her races anyway. If some of these roughies decide to make this a solidly run mile and a half, then she is the one they have to hold out, not **Eskimo Queen** who is the other winning chance in the race. Did catch the eye in the Roses, but just as happy with Lasoron's performance. Admittedly not a lot between them.
