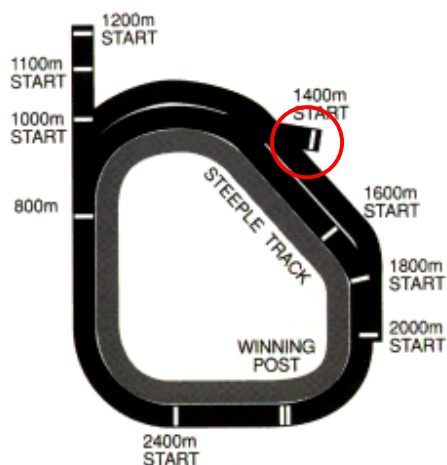

\$4.00 Stumbled this grade last prep, but race is run to suit perfectly. Go close  
 \$4.50 Better for the one run back. Needs speed on, but will round most up.  
 \$4.50 Awkwardly drawn, but races well here. Class galloper.

### Best Roughie:

12 Cinque Cento (C Newitt) \$11.0 Improved mare. Her biggest advantage is no pace & good fresh record.

### Betting Suggestions:

Small win bet Miss Finland. Pace the key in this race. If saving, the value is through Zupaone and Cinque Cento.

### Race Summary:

Intriguing race with predominantly middle distance gallopers, cruelled by any genuine speed. With no Regal Roller/Apache Cat type on-speed runner, this is a risk of being a crawl. This places the likes of **Zupaone**, **Miss Finland** and **Cinque Cento** at an advantage. Keen obviously to watch Haradasun and El Segundo. Efficient, Lad of The Manor and Falstaff are all interesting runners. Keen to see what they can produce. Activation, Maybe Better, and Blutigeroo can be watched from a Caulfield Cup point of view.
