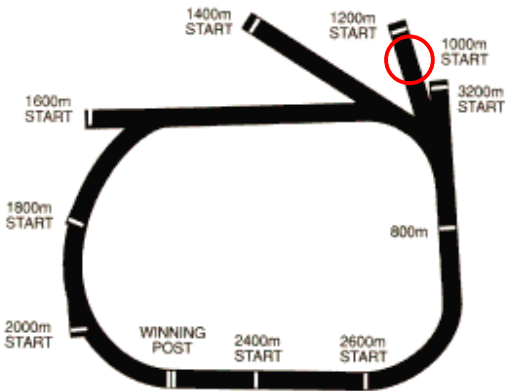

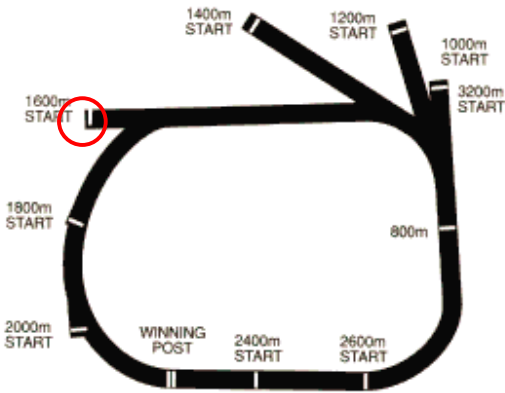
Race Summary:

Magnus won this race last year with form no stronger than what he brings in this year. He was 3rd in the Oakleigh Plate behind Undue, before a close up 4th in the Newmarket behind Miss Andretti and Gold Edition. This year he has been runner-up in both key lead-up races behind the rising superstar Weekend Hussler who would be a odds-on favourite if he was kept fresh and contested this. No runner has the form that Magnus has coming into this. **Hurried Choice** looks a lightweight boilover chance. Nice performance last start and with speed on, will be rattling down the outside. If **Bentley Biscuit** can be forgiven for his last run, then he has to be considered and will finish in the mix. **Typhoon Zed** and **Keen Commander** are both weighted to give a big sight and are courageous sprinters who will box on. **Fritz's Princess** needs a hot tempo and is probably looking for a little further now, but has no weight and is racing well.

#2 Desert War & #10 Arlington

Race Summary:

Not a lot of tempo on paper, and the race has lost its genuine group 1 feel with the scratching of topweight Racing To Win. Last year's Coolmore Classic **Tuesday Joy** looks to have come back in superb order and falls on top now. Will give them a start, but has the class to reel this lot in. Look for her down the centre of the track. I still have concerns about **Sniper's Bullet** at Weight For Age, but this isn't a classic WFA contest. He looks in this up to his ears now. **Guillotine** is the knockout horse. A genuine Derby type who is being asked a lot to resume in a Randwick mile, but David Payne knows what he's doing. A much different, and probably less suitable 3yo, to the athletic He's No Pie Eater who caused an upset in this race last year. I'm expecting some nice work late all the same. **Casino Prince** and **Honor In War** are on a line, round out the winning hopes.

Despite the race conditions appearing suitable, I need to see more from Desert War before I can consider him. Like stablemate Bentley Biscuit, turned in a poor performance first-up, but the difference between "forgiving" the two runners, is that Bentley Biscuit trialed very well before failing. Desert War has looked very flat this time in. I will consider laying both he and Arlington even though the speed map suits. Small field and both are about 3 and 5 points under the odds respectively.
