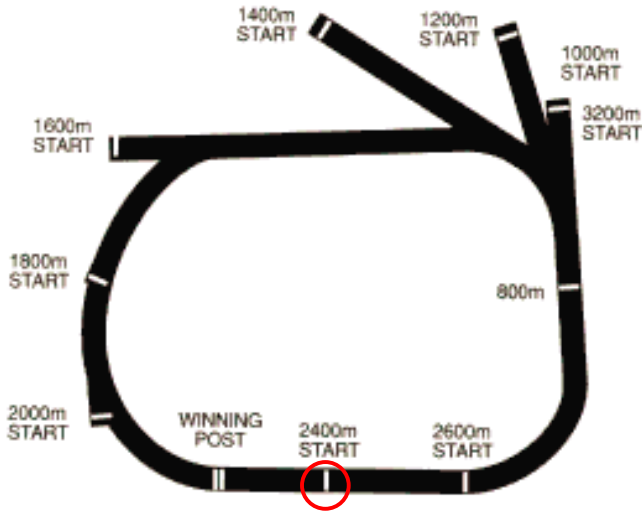

Race Summary:

Unlike previous years, I'm not at all enthused with the Arrowfield/Adrian Knox form and will get right away from it for this. They are typically the races to find the winner, but I think this year may be different. I'm taken by **Boundless** and witnessing the b-grade kiwis run 1-2 in our Derby didn't do anything to harm my confidence, or lack thereof in our own 3yo stayers! This filly is very adaptable and was explosive last start, and tough as teak the start prior when leading and winning the NZ Oaks, beating the likes of Pentura who was competitive in our Arrowfield. Pentura beat home Raise, who then came out to win our Adrian Knox by a margin. With all that in mind, I'm happy to gamble on Boundless. She looks very genuine. **Zarita** is in great form and represents the danger. Shooting for 5 on end, and not many reasons to say she won't do it. **Heavenly Glow** looked good in the Arrowfield, but again, I'm not overly enthused by the form despite **Raise's** big win out of the race. **Grand Journey** is rock hard fit and in-form winning both the Oaks and Derby in WA and maybe the boilover in the race.
