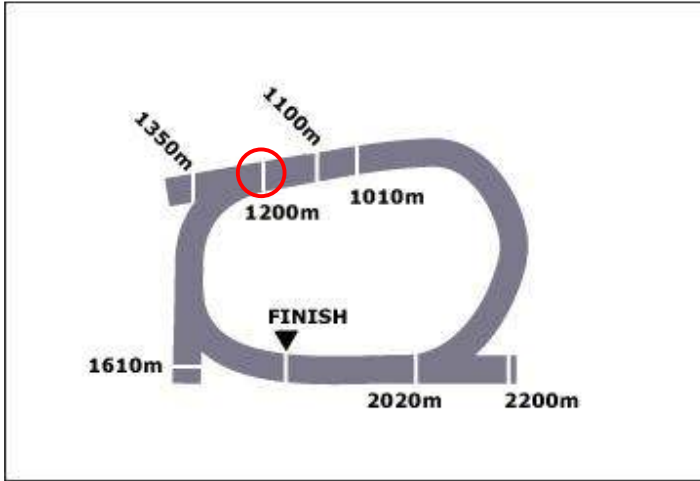

### Race Summary:

Never been a big fan of the saying odds-on, look-on, but it's hard to recommend stepping into the \$1.40. I will most likely bet right up if they bet better than 1.50 **Apache Cat**, because he's a better than 2's on chance in this. He is bullet proof first and second up, and has found a soft WFA race. **Vormista** has been a mare I've been keen on for some time. I was disappointed not to see her in the Autumn. Very talented mare who doesn't have to improve to run 2<sup>nd</sup> here. WFA against Apache 2<sup>nd</sup>-up is a massive ask, but I'll be having 1 or 2 units on her for every 10 I have on Apache Cat. Take your pick, **Swick** or **Swiss Ace** for the minors. Neither can beat Apache Cat under this weight scale. 3yo Swiss Ace has the advantage of being the lone leader and in-form Queensland (local) sprinter, if any of the others haven't travelled up well or are off their game. The only reason I think the tempo will be even, and not slow or moderate, is due to his presence. Can dictate terms to suit and run time
