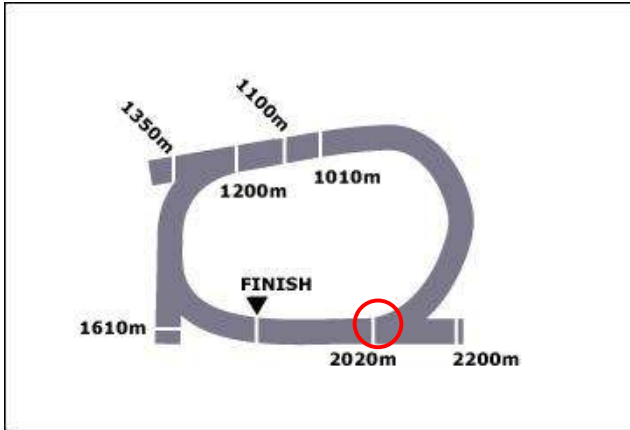

Race Summary:

A lot of go-forward drawn out and subsequently good tempo in the race. This has forced my hand to look for something that is going to settle and run on hard. I typically don't like backing horses getting too far back at Doomben, but the race looks to suit it. I have a big question mark over the Hollindale being WFA form, so I'm looking to the horses up from Sydney in **Eskimo Queen**, **Viewed** and **Sarrera**, who are the key runners for mine. Not a lot of interest in the race, so I'll be looking to play small. **Eskimo Queen** comes into this from the Doncaster, after winning the Coolmore Classic and is sure to run a big race. **Viewed** has to step right up in grade, but won't find a more winnable WFA race than this. On being in form alone, he can figure. **Sarrera** won the Queen Elizabeth at any old price, but looks to have returned in career-best form this prep and beat Tuesday Joy last start who would be nice and short in this. **Scenic Shot** has plenty of ability. Runner-up to Devil Moon in last season's Turnbull over 2000m, beating home Haradasun and other handy horses. He was always going to win the Hollindale so it is hard to dismiss him. Still might be more a handicapper, like a lot of the others. **Value** chances are **Lasoron** and **Grand Zulu**.
