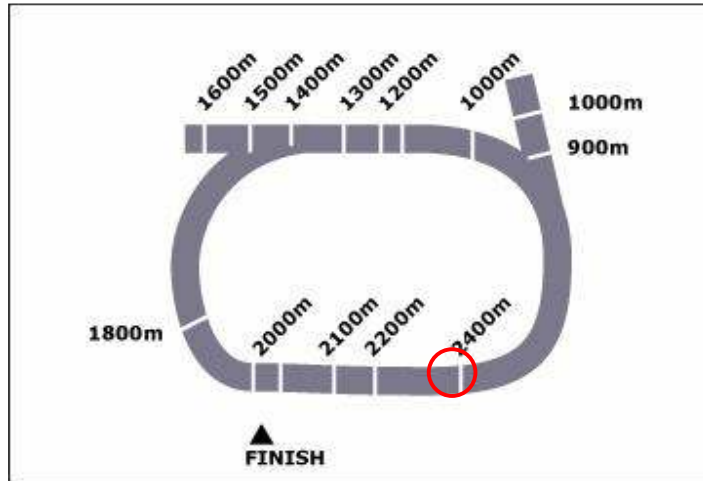

- \$8.0 Well bred colt. Handles conditions, gives the impression 2400 will suit.

### Race Summary:

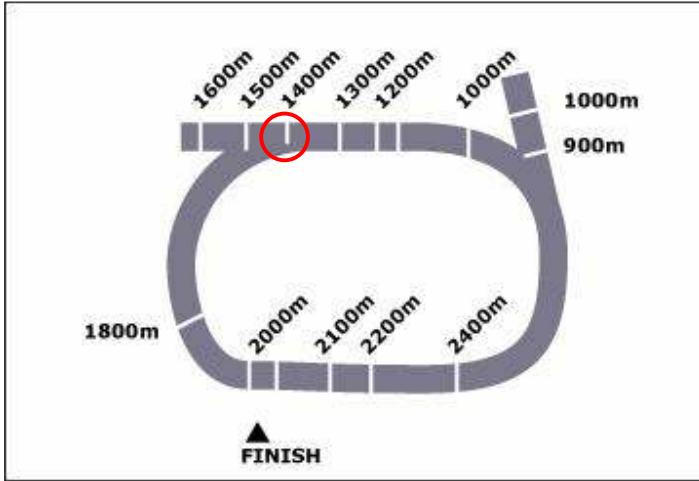
**Moatize** is the obvious pick for mine. He is the improving stayer on the up and I get the feeling he will get the trip stronger than recent foe **Mission Critical**. Leaning his way and prefer to risk Mission Critical at the journey. Despite 1 win from 16 goes, **Rathsallagh** really looks to be warming to this. One of the few carnivals where the Derby is run after the Oaks, and gives fillies like this the edge of having the miles under her belt. Handles all conditions, and I can see her running a race in this against a lacklustre field of colts and geldings. I still had a question mark over **Riva San** at the mile and a half and subsequently left her out of Oaks calculations. Now she is proven at the trip, I think you have to include her. **Formula One Racer** is a horse I could spec. Out of a former handy middle distance/staying Zabeel mare Primrose Sands. Watch betting.

### Race Summary:

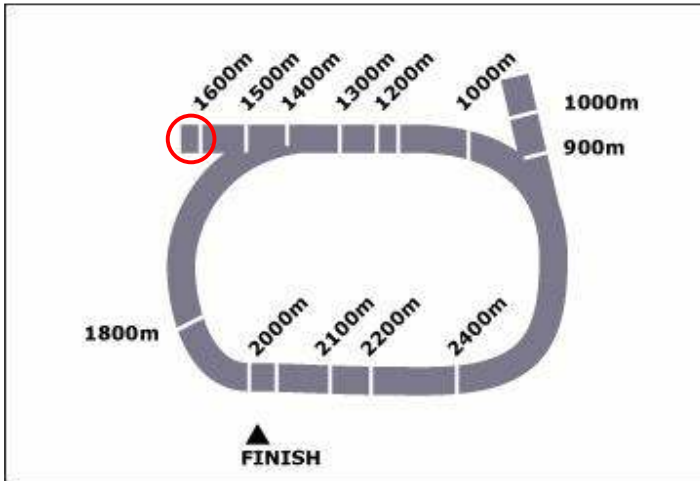
I've always viewed the Stradbroke as a lightweight's race. Unfortunately with the weights raised, the lightly weighted horses are now quite close to the topweights (Casino Prince and Sniper's Bullet). With the speed on in the most genuinely run 7furlongs on our calendar, I still want to be on lightly weighted strong finishers. **El Cambio** and **Vormista** fit the bill this year. **El Cambio** has raced well since coming up to Brisbane. Has drawn poorly, but will settle back and finish off. A winner on a heavy track and an in-form jockey on top. **Vormista** didn't figure last start, but caught the eye first-up behind Apache Cat. She brings some of the best current sprint form (Apache Cat) into the race, and looks a likely type 3<sup>rd</sup>-up at 1400m from a perfect draw outside the race favourite. **Casino Prince** has drawn well and has arguably THE best form in the race. Runs behind Weekend Hussler, Racing To Win and a near-win in the Doncaster is all class form for this race. I didn't include a 4<sup>th</sup> pick for this race, because I think there are literally 8 horses on a line who will be finishing just behind the main hopes.
