Race Summary:

The Superstar of the turf **Weekend Hussler** hasn't scared off all opposition (yet). This is an excellent field with many worthy opponents lining up to beat him at his first try beyond 1600m. He looks the winner and is impossible to oppose until he fails. The Caulfield 1800m is no harder than the Randwick and Flemington miles that he has already conquered. Last year's Caulfield Cup favourite **Maldivian** can only improve with racing and this journey is just about right for him. He is the tough horse in the field who can upset the younger brigade. **Light Fantastic** and **Zarita** are both in for good preps. Probably a shade below Weekend Hussler at the moment, but both look capable of the trip and will keep the favourite honest. Of the others, **Pompeii Ruler** commands respect at the track and journey.

Race Summary:

Bon Hoffa was far too good in the Bobbie Lewis before winning this race last Spring. Looks on track for a repeat effort after saluting in the Bobbie Lewis first-up. Drawn the inside and will need his share of luck with his racing pattern, but can beat them if he gets it. There are plenty of other handy run-on horses that should be in the mix with him, providing the pace is genuine, as anticipated. **Swick** is a strong finisher. Despite the track being somewhat unsuitable and him being more a Flemington horse. **Orange County** warmed up at the right time last start and is working towards winning a race like this. **J'Adane** is the interesting runner. A talented and adaptable mare who can hit the line off a tempo. **Rubiscent** is the knockout. Despite this being a Group 1, this is a drop in grade for him, getting away from the Weekend Hussler form. Emergency **Serious Speed** is drawn to run well 2nd-up. **Kingda Ka** can give a lot of cheek with the lightweight first-up if he gains a start.
