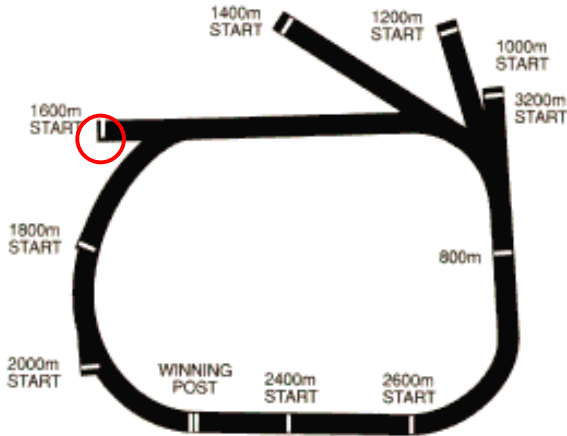

Race Summary:

Triple Honour was short odds-on last start when beaten by Gallant Tess. With Waller's training style in mind, I get the feeling he was just too soft for the mile that time out, but should be primed for this. He's a class animal who showed how good he was winning the Premiere first-up, after a spell and a Doncaster win. Looks the real deal and should get them today. **Duporth** is a spanner in the works. He looks a legitimate lightweight chance if they opt to go this way, with some reservations about the distance after a setback. If he doesn't run, then the dangers will come from **Gallant Tess** and **Mentality**. **Gallant Tess** is a very honest mare who does little wrong. She's always there if the others are having an off day. **Mentality** should be ready to show something, 3d-up and up to the mile. Epsom fancy **Ashikaga** looks badly placed at the weights.
