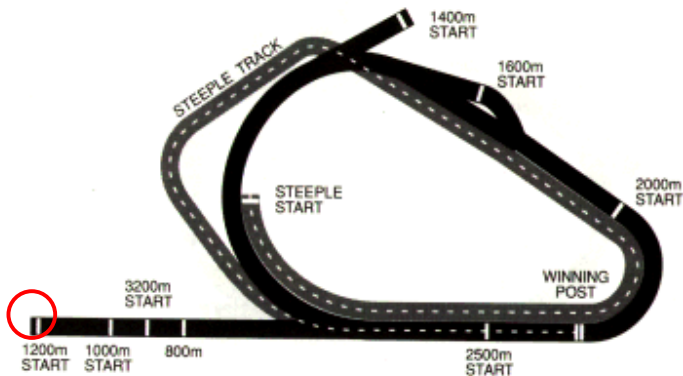

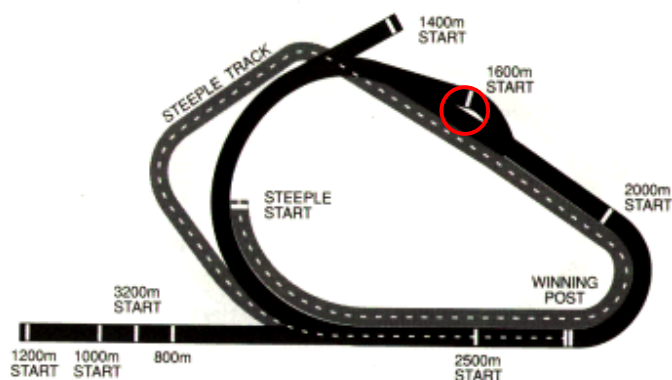
Race Summary:

They will probably go to one side here (the outside), but I'm just not sure, so I have split them up. Barring bad luck, **Apache Cat** will win this first-up at his only race of the carnival. He is one of the best "fresh" horses in training. His first and second-up record in the top grade will rival any galloper in Australia. Corey will sit behind the leader Keen Commander, who should go well enough to take him right inside the 400m, then as long as Apache gets out, the show's over. His main danger is the ever-improving **Sunburnt Lad**. Should get a nice enough run in transit today after not getting a look at them in Hot Danish's Salinger. Had a flashing light on there when running 3rd. **Triple Honour** commands respect. He is a Doncaster winner, unbeaten first-up, and drawn to get the right run. He appears to have settled in OK, and looks a real threat for the placings. **Bel Mer** rounds out the chances for the multis players.

Race Summary:

The Epsom initially looked a strange race with the first few in the running, placing in the race on a leaderish wet track, however the form has held up. Winner Theseo has gone on to race well against the best Melbourne could dish up to him and 4th placegetter All Silent won like a good thing on Derby Day. Today we get to see runner-up **Bank Robber** who like Theseo drew wide, raced deep on the speed and boxed on to fight out the finish in the Epsom. Should get across ok today and providing his stablemate Royal Discretion doesn't drive him mad, will be in this for a very long way. **All Silent** with the same formline, follow-up by a Flemington win is the logical danger. Has the advantage of having been around the Flemington mile and has also drawn well. This is probably an afterthought for **Mimi Lebrock**, but she's racing too well to dismiss. Won't have to work today, is rock hard fit and brings the mares (Forensics) form into the race. Worth including. **Valedictum** heads a very long list of place chances in the race. He is set for this race every year, and always runs well in it. No reason to expect anything different this year, but if playing exotics, the minor places are probably "field" jobs! As good a fit that this horse looks for the race, I'm going to go out on a limb and risk **Sea Battle** after being asked to do some wide racing.
