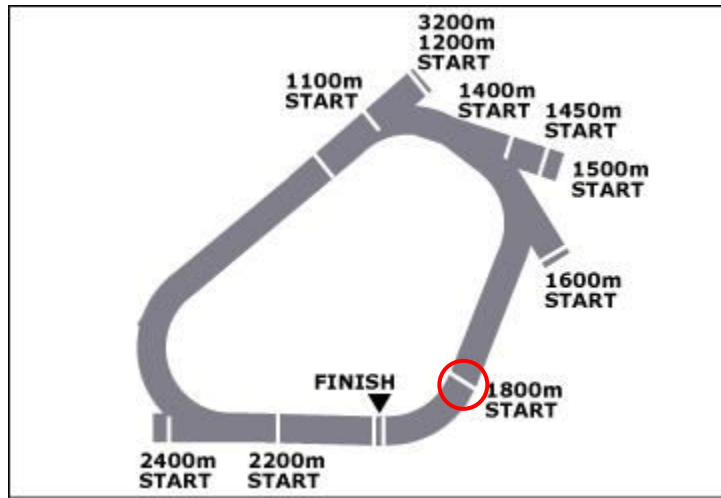

Race Summary:

Many of the horses who were well placed in the Railway under handicap conditions are much worse off today at Weight For Age, including the local winner Gilded Venom. This is really a race for the class horses. **Marasco** ran right up to his best behind Takeover Target and Apache Cat last start in a clearly unsuitable race. That sprint form is going to be very strong in this WFA over the more suitable 9furlongs. In his 2 runs at the trip. His 2 runs at the trip were both for placings in stronger races, splitting Pompeii Ruler and Aqua D'Amore in the St George and 3rd to the previously in-form Rubiscent and Miss Finland in the Underwood. **Sniper's Bullet** looks clearly the horse to beat and testing material off his Railway run, meeting the winner 3kg (2lengths) better at the weights today. This distance remains the only small query with him. Has been a sprinter-miler up until now. **Niconero** was running home strongly last start and looks a big chance of going a couple of places better today. Probably wants a little more speed than is on paper, but so too do many of his main rivals. Have to respect him on class. **Gilded Venom** is the exciting local horse in good form. He snuck up on me a little to win the Railway as a horse who looked under the odds. Should be about the same price as last start to win this.
