Tolart won her maiden 4 runs back over 1400m with 58kg on a slow track & tried a mile for the 1st time last start. She quickened well at the end of that winning by 2l & was just a second outside the track record. Up in class & distance but she's an improver.

She has a very good record at Moonee Valley, is extremely well weighted and this trip looks like it will suit her to a tee.

She has handy male opposition here in Duporth and Dreamscape, but today we get a real look at how good this Samantha Miss form is, and I get the feeling it is pretty good. **Love And Kisses** has looked the second best filly to the strong Samantha Miss and with Cox Plate plans for the star filly, I would expect Love And Kisses to turn up here today getting 2kg off the boys, and beat them. Outside of Sebring, it was all the fillies in the 2yo Triple Crown races, and Love and Kisses was one of them. Happy to be on her.

Race 9 # 8 Dealers
 Rated: 3.0
 Expected: 4.0

Although first-choice hoop Kerrin McEvoy rides stablemate Disciplined, who is unbeaten this time in, I think **Dealers** is the way to go here. I have a lot of time for this formline around Kilton and Strat's Flyer, with linking form through My Vegas and also Black Piranha who both ran bottlers last start. From Barrier 4 with in-form Brown on top, this fellow looks a bombproof each-way bet.

No Wine No Song 2008 Sydney Cup Winner

Punters face an 8 race card at Belmont which clearly lacks both depth and quality with the plight of the punter further exacerbated by the likelihood of a rain affected track. The first of our two each way selections for this meet appears in the way of **NALINGASON** in race 7 (rated 5.50). Not a great race being a class 2 on a Saturday card, but Nalingason really looks placed to advantage here, after performing credibly last campaign in open class races around the likes of Cohort, Snip Esprit and Kereign. In the last **KANTURK** (rated 4.40) has a decisive form advantage over rivals here and we expect him to annex this one first up.
